Here's How It Works



- 1** Tax Credit. The federal tax credit can save you up to \$1500 if your windows and doors meet the qualifying efficiency requirements. The tax credit is part of the Economic Stimulus Plan (American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009)¹, which extends federal tax credits to “qualified energy improvements” for 2009 and 2010. The tax credit allows you to receive up to 30% of the amount paid for the qualifying product, or up to \$1500 total maximum credit for any and all improvements.

Here's how to qualify for the tax credit:

- Windows and doors must meet a 0.30 U-factor and 0.30 SHGC or better². Check with your Milgard dealer for more information about our wide range of products that meet this standard.
- The credit applies to the cost of the product only and does not include installation costs.
- Qualifying windows or doors must be installed between February 18, 2009 and December 31, 2010.

- 2** Milgard's mail-in rebate¹ is just one more way you can save up to an additional \$750, regardless of your qualifications for the federal tax credit². With the 3D MAX™ energy package added to Milgard Tuscan™ Series replacement windows³ and Milgard Classic™ Series patio doors, you could be eligible for rebates of \$25 per window and \$75 per door, up to a maximum rebate of \$750.

Here's how to qualify for the Milgard energy rebate:

- Mail in the Energy Rebate card within 60 days of your purchase – Milgard will validate the claim and issue buyers a rebate check for all qualifying purchases within 8 weeks upon receipt of the rebate card.
- Offer applies to the cost of the product only and does not include installation costs.
- A minimum purchase of five Milgard replacement windows and/or doors is required.
- Offer applies to purchase agreements made between a Milgard Certified Dealer and homeowner⁴.
- Offer is only valid for one rebate per household, not to be used more than once.
- The Milgard Energy Rebate cannot be combined with any other Milgard offers.
- Valid only at Milgard Dealers from March 13, 2009 to June 30, 2009.

² Most Milgard products with the 3D MAX energy package upgrade will qualify for the federal tax credit. However, the federal tax credit and the Milgard rebate are mutually exclusive, each one having its own set of qualifying criteria.

³ Products shipped to altitudes higher than the elevation of manufacture may require capillary tubes to relieve pressure in the insulated glass units depending on the variance of altitude. - 3** Energy savings. According to ENERGY STAR®, installing new, energy efficient windows and doors can save you up to another \$460¹ annually. This number is based on an average 2000 sq. ft. home with 300 sq. ft. of window area. Estimates use the Energy Information Administration's 2005 average gas prices and year-to-date through June 2006 electricity prices. Actual savings will vary by climate region and home characteristics.
